Syllabus Update – Winter 2022

Prerequisites: The 2nd half of this course makes heavy use of Linear Algebra. Thus, the knowledge of a course in Linear Algebra (e.g. Math 110, 111 or 112) is absolutely necessary. Some knowledge of Calculus is also required.

Assignments: The weekly assignments will be handed in via Crowdmark. They are due on Fridays at 12:30pm (as in the last semester).

Tests: The second midterm will be on 3rd March at 9:30-10:20. If possible, it will be written in class, otherwise online via Crowdmark.

Exams: There will be a final exam in April. This will be scheduled by the exam office.
